



Announcement of Mahidol University

On

Additional Guidelines for Academic Provision and Work from Home to Strengthen Control Measures of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19)

Reference is made to the Announcement of Bangkok Metropolitan Administration (BMA) on the Temporary Closure of Premises (No. 29) dated the 16th May 2021 and the Announcement of Nakhon Pathom Province on Measures to Prevent the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) in All Academic Institutions dated the 20th May 2021. Mahidol University would like to announce additional guidelines in alignment with the above-mentioned announcements as follows:

1. All faculties/colleges/institutes in Phayathai and Bangkok Noi campuses are still not authorized to use the premises for teaching and learning, examinations, research or other academic activities as mentioned in Mahidol University's Announcement on the Guidelines for Academic Provision and Work from Home to Strengthen Control Measures of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID – 19) dated the 30th April 2021 and Mahidol University's Announcement on the Extension of the Announcement on the Guidelines for Academic Provision and Work from Home to Strengthen Control Measures of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID – 19) dated the 14th May 2021.
2. All faculties/colleges/institutes in Salaya campus are allowed to use the premises and accommodate a large crowd for the purpose of teaching and learning, examinations, research and other academic activities as seen appropriate. However, faculties/colleges/institutes are to conduct an online self-assessment via the Thai Stop Covid+ in order to report to the Committee for Disease Control of Nakhon Pathom Province for consideration. All the measures relating to the prevention of the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID – 19) must also be strictly observed in all those events.

3. Faculties/colleges/institutes in Salaya campus planning to convene other activities apart from those mentioned in Item No. 2 above with the number of attendance less than 50 people are to submit plans of events to the District Office for permission prior to the event organization.
4. All heads of faculties/colleges/institutes and vice presidents responsible for units and divisions in the Office of the President are to encourage staff members and students not to travel to the 4 highest maximum controlled areas, including Bangkok, Pathum Thani, Nonthaburi, and Samut Prakan Province. Provided that staff members or students are residing in those areas, it is advised that they work from home or participate in teaching and learning through the online channels and systems. Some staff members may be authorized to work on-site as seen appropriate, especially in those in healthcare services and security units, so on and so forth.

Please be advised accordingly. This announcement enters into effect from this date onwards until further notice.
