



Announcement of the President of Mahidol University on

The Results of the Tests for the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-2019) of Individuals
with Close Contacts with Infected Student

(For Internal and External Circulation)

Reference is made to the announcement circulated within Mahidol University regarding the initial report of the confirmed case found at the College of Sport Science and Technology, Mahidol University, and the later announcement updating on the measures undertaken to suspend the normal classes at Mahidol University Salaya Campus during 16th – 22nd March 2020.

On 16th March 2020, the College of Sport Science and Technology and the Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University, performed the swab tests among 58 individuals with close contact with the student who contracted the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-2019). The tests came out undetectable for 54 cases and inconclusive for 4 cases. For the inconclusive cases, those individuals are considered a low risk group.

Following the medical procedures, all 58 individuals are advised to undergo self-quarantine at home for another 14 days. The remaining 4 inconclusive cases will be retested again and followed up closely by the Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University. Mahidol University will monitor their conditions and keep the public informed accordingly.
