



Announcement of Mahidol University

Guidelines for Operations under the State of Emergency Announcement

Reference is made to the release of the Thai government's State of Emergency Announcement and the provisions under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation B.E. 2548 (No. 25) dated the 26th June 2021, Mahidol University would like to announce guidelines for operations as follows:

1. All heads of faculties/colleges/institutes in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Salaya Campus and vice presidents responsible for units and divisions in the Office of the President are to inform staff members and students not to travel to the 10 highest maximum controlled areas, including Bangkok, Nakhon Pathom, Nonthaburi, Narathiwat, Pathum Thani, Pattani, Yala, Songkhla, Samut Prakarn and Samut Sakorn Province. Provided that staff members or students are residing in those areas, it is advised that they work from home or participate in teaching and learning through the online channels and systems. Some staff members may be authorized to work on-site as seen appropriate, especially those in healthcare services, vaccination sites and security units, so on and so forth.
2. All faculties/colleges/institute in every campus are to follow Mahidol University's Guideline for Undergraduate Teaching and Learning (Academic Year 2564) dated the 23rd June 2021. Heads of faculties/colleges/institutes are authorized to offer online teaching and learning, assessments and other academic activities through online systems as seen appropriate.

3. All faculties/colleges/institutes in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Salaya campuses are encouraged to cancel or postpone social functions and other recreational activities, except those pre-scheduled traditional ceremonies. All faculties/colleges/institutes in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Salaya campus are allowed to use the premises for activities with participants less than 20 people, pending a permission from their respective local authorities. Faculties/colleges/institutes in Salaya campus are to conduct an online self-assessment via the Thai Stop Covid+ in order to report to the Committee for Disease Control of Nakhon Pathom Province for consideration. All measures relating to the prevention of the outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID – 19) must also be strictly observed in all events.

4. Faculties/colleges/institutes in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Salaya campus are to temporarily close down all construction sites and operations and limit the mobility of construction workforce for 30 days, starting from the 28th June 2021 onwards.

Please be advised accordingly. This announcement enters into effect from the 28th June 2021 onwards until further notice.
