



Announcement of Mahidol University
Working from Home for University Personnel
and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings
in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Campuses in Provincial Areas

Reference is made to the Announcement of Mahidol University on the Closure of Mahidol University Salaya Campus and the Use of Online System for Academic Activities and Meetings dated the 23rd December 2020. Due to the new surge of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and the unpredictable nature of the current spread, Mahidol University would like to further announce the followings:

- 1) Vice Presidents overseeing campuses in Kanchanaburi, Nakhon Sawan and Amnat Charoen as well as Heads of faculties/colleges/institutes in Phyathai and Bangkok Noi campuses are to consider advising all staff members to work from home (WFH), except the units responsible for delivering services to the public such as hospitals, dental units or security/ safety units. Vice Presidents and Heads of faculties/ colleges/ institutes are authorized to advise their staff on the detailed measures regarding the service delivery and to monitor workloads as seen appropriate in order to ensure the efficiency and the continuity of the workplace in other functions.
- 2) Staff members who have to commute to their respective campuses and faculties/colleges/institutes are advised to strictly follow the precaution guideline of the Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health, including the distancing measure, mask wearing and the use of Thaichana application, and so on.
- 3) All Teaching and learning, final examinations, other academic activities, university or faculty meetings in the above-mentioned campuses are to be convened using the

online system as seen appropriate by Vice Presidents and Heads of faculties/colleges/institutes.

This announcement enters into effect from this date on until the 3rd January 2021.
