## MUSC's Department of Physics Welcomed Prof. Dr. Koji Wakita, an Outstanding Researcher in Earth Science, Yamaguchi University, Japan





Friday 24<sup>th</sup>, March 2017 – Vice Dean Kanyaratt Supaibulwatana represented the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University together with Assist. Prof. Dr. Tosporn Boonyarith, Head of Department of Physics and Lect. Dr. Puwis Amatyakul, a Researcher in Physic, jointly welcomed Prof. Dr. Koji Wakita, a Researcher in Earth Science, Division of Earth Science, Graduate School of Sciences and Technology for Innovation, Yamaguchi University, Japan, during 02.00- 03.00 p.m. at K102 Room, Chalermprakiat Building.

Prof. Wakita visited Thailand to explore new feasible collaborations in Physics education and research innovation, in particularly seeking for new research areas and potential partners in Mahidol University, Phayathai and Kanchanaburi Campuses, focusing on geosciences and earth study. In this connection, visiting to the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University was to learn a body structure and expertise of staff members in science school as well as to explore new connections and future cooperation feasibility with researchers working in the same research areas. Official visit to the Department of Physics was also organized to serve the purpose in this matter.

Prof. Wakita also presented a Summer Program 2017 offering by the Faculty of Science, Yamaguchi University where foreign students including undergraduate students from MUSC can take part to fulfill their experiences in academic and cultures in Yamaguchi Prefecture, Japan, during August 27<sup>th</sup> to September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017. This program is offered with free of charge but only few expenses are required for local accommodation and living expenditures. Only 2-3seats are possible for MUSC's students, while total number of the foreign students is limited to 30 persons. Universities should submit the group application and send passport copy of each student by email to Yamaguchi University directly, deadline for application is 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2017.
