




## Guideline for ATK Positive and High Risk Cases

#### ATK Tested Positive






## HIGH RISK CASES

### Close contacts (No. 0)



- Classmates, roommates or close acquaintances.
- Those who had close contact with Case No. 0 within 1 meter more than 5 minutes or was exposed to sneezes or coughs from Case No. 0 without protective gears (masks off during exposure).
- Those who were in the same space without proper ventilation with Case No. 0 within 1 meter more than 5 minutes.






## LOW RISK CASES

Those who do not meet with high risk criteria:



- Self - Monitoring;
- Observe symptoms;
- Avoid a large crowd;
- Class attendance is allowed with masks on; and
- DMHTT Protocols



- If case No.1 has shown symptoms and been tested positive, the person will become case No.0;
- Case No.2 will have to undergo an ATK test on the 3rd day after the exposure to case No.1 and Self - Quarantine for 10-14 days is needed after case No.1 was tested positive.
