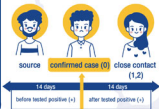


## Source of Disease and Close Contact of COVID-19 Confirmed Case



Source investigation:  
14 days before tested positive



## Close Contact Investigation:

Confirmed case (0) with positive test result (+)



Confirmed Case

- Person with positive test result has to be quarantined in the hospital or a cohort ward.



High Risk Contact

- (person with close contact with (0))
- Carry on a conversation with confirmed case within 1-meter range for longer than 5 minutes or expose to confirmed case's droplets.
  - Person in enclosed space without a proper ventilation system with confirmed case within 1-meter range for longer than 15 minutes.



Low Risk Contact

(person who are not considered as high risk contact)



## Procedures for Close Contact



Screening/ Testing

- If any symptoms below have been developed; body temperature rises above 37.5 °C, cough, sore throat, having phlegm, breathing difficulty, panting, muscle pain or headache, go for a screening or a test immediately
- At present, hospitals will conduct the screening/ testing only when symptoms are present.



14 days Home-Quarantine

- Monitor yourself. If any symptoms have been shown, go to the hospital for the screening/ testing.
- If there are no symptoms after 14 days, live normally and always wear mask.



Stay at home for 7 days. Then always wear mask when going out.



If (1) has shown symptoms and tested positive, (1) will become a confirmed case (0) and (2) will become (1) automatically. A home-quarantine is applied to complete the 14-day quarantine.
