- Students already paid the tuition fees, unless being waived



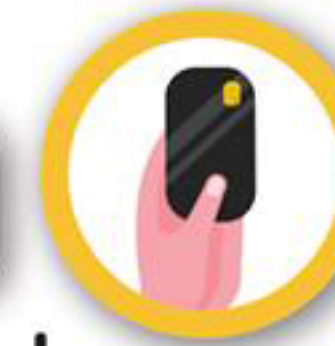

- from February 1st, 2021 to March 19th, 2022



Coverage limit

- ▶ COVID-19 **50,000 THB**
- ▶ Accident **10,000 THB**

(the accident insurance policy covers only in the case of loss of life, dismemberment, loss of sight or permanent disability resulted from accidents)
