



Faculty of Science Mahidol University Announcement

Subject: Scholarship for Young Scientists for Academic Year 2021 (B.E.2564)

As the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University aims to provide the Scholarship for Young Scientists for Graduate Students of academic year 2021 and doctoral students of second semester, academic year 2020. By virtue of item 22 (22.4) of Mahidol University Announcement on Regulations and Methods to Receive, Maintain, Pay, and Control Money B.E. 2551, the Dean of Faculty of Science, with the agreement of the Faculty Committee in its 3/2564 meeting on 24 March 2021 (B.E.2564), enacted the following announcement regarding the Scholarship for Young Scientists for Academic Year 2021:

1. The Faculty of Science Mahidol University Announcement, Subject: Scholarship for Young Scientist for Academic Year 2020 dated 16 June 2020 shall be repealed.
2. Types and Qualifications of Applicant

The applicant must have passed the selection and enrolled as a graduate student in the program affiliated with the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University in academic year 2021. The applicant must not be receiving other scholarship that supports monthly expenses, tuition fees, or receiving monthly wages. There are 2 types of applicants in this announcement:

2.1 Type 1 (Tuition Fee Support)

The Faculty of Science and the program will provide the tuition fees of subjects delivered by the Faculty of Science, subject code SC... (Does NOT include the fees of Thesis subjects and Qualification Examinations).

2.2 Type 2 (Tuition Fee Support with Monthly Financial Support)

The Faculty of Science and the program will provide the tuition fees of subjects delivered by the Faculty of Science, subject code SC... (Does NOT include the fees of Thesis subjects and Qualification Examinations) as well as providing a monthly financial support of 8,000 baht per month for 1 academic year. 75 Scholarships of this type are available.

2.2.1 Qualifications of Type 2 Applicants

The applicant must display a good academic performance as follows:

1. Master Students: graduated with at least 3.00 GPA in Bachelor Degree
2. Doctoral Students: graduated from the Bachelor or Master's Degree with at least 3.25 GPA.

2.2.2 Obligations while receiving Type 2 Scholarship

1. Contribute to the work of the Faculty of Science or attend community services that utilize the scientific knowledge, accounting to no less than 10 hours **AND**
2. Oversee the faculty's examination according to the date and time specified by the faculty, accounting to no less than 9 hours.
3. The department or program shall make a report of activities and submit to the Faculty of Science at the end of each semester using the provided form.

3. Scholarship Criteria

- 3.1 Must be a full-time student
- 3.2 Has a registration of at least 9 credits per semester, excluding the audit credits (**EXCEPT** for registration made as part of the curriculum)
- 3.3 If the student is found to be receiving another scholarship support of the same type during the duration of the young scientist scholarship, the student must return the received scholarship to the Faculty of Science in full amount.
- 3.4 In cases where the student receives a monthly scholarship support from another source, the student may receive only the tuition fee as partial scholarship.
- 3.5 In cases where the student receives a tuition fee support from another source of scholarship, the student may receive only the monthly support as partial scholarship.

4. Termination of Scholarship

The Young Scientist Scholarship shall be terminated in the following conditions:

- 4.1 The recipient quits being the student of the Faculty of Science while receiving the scholarship.
- 4.2 The student exhibits inappropriate behavior or severe breach of discipline, according to the regulations of Mahidol University.
- 4.3 The student provided false information or did not inform the faculty of other sources of scholarship.
- 4.4 Force majeure that made the student unable to continue the study.
- 4.5 End of the scholarship duration

Should item 4.1 - 4.3 applies, the **Department/Program must report to the Faculty of Science within 15 days**, and the student must return the monthly support received to the Faculty of Science in full amount.

5. Application Procedures

- 5.1 The Faculty of Science announces the Young Scientist Scholarship
- 5.2 The department or program considers the students with qualifications and submit to the Faculty of Science for consideration, along with the necessary documents:
 - 5.2.1 Completed the Young Scientist Scholarship Application Form
 - 5.2.2 One 3 x 4 cm photograph
 - 5.2.3 One copy of academic transcript
- 5.3 The Faculty of Science announces the scholarship recipients via the department or the program.

If the Faculty of Science finds that the applicant has submitted incomplete, inaccurate, or falsified documents or does not possess the specified qualifications, the scholarship will be revoked and the received scholarship must be returned in full amount.

6. Application Schedule and Announcement Dates

Application Schedule:

First Semester, First Round, 50 scholarships	Until 17 May 2021
First Semester, Second Round, 15 scholarships	18 May – 15 July 2021
Second Semester, 10 scholarships	Until 15 November 2021
Recipient Announcement of First Semester, First Round	31 May 2021, via the department/program
Recipient Announcement of First Semester, Second Round	30 July 2021, via the department/program
Recipient Announcement of Second Semester	30 November 2021, via the department/program

In cases where the number of recipients does not exceed the available quota, the quota may be carried over to the next round of application within the same academic year.

7. In cases where the aforementioned do not apply, the Dean shall consider and rule the case. The decision of the Dean shall be regarded as final.
