



## Announcement of the Faculty of Science

### Regarding the Scholarship for Young Scientists Academic Year 2026

.....

The Faculty of Science, Mahidol University, wishes to offer the Scholarship for Young Scientists for graduate students in the first and second semesters of the academic year 2026.

By virtue of the authority under item 22.4 and item 23 of the Mahidol University Announcement regarding the Criteria and Methods for Receiving Money, Safekeeping Money, Withdrawing Money, Paying Money, and Controlling Money Disbursement B.E. 2551 and its amendments, which were issued under item 38 of the Mahidol University Regulations regarding Budget and Financial Management B.E. 2551 and its amendments, combined with the resolution of the Faculty of Science Committee Meeting No. 1/2026 on December 26, B.E. 2568, the Dean of the Faculty of Science hereby issues this announcement:

**Item 1** In this announcement:

"Faculty of Science" means the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University.

"Program" means the graduate-level program of the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University. "Student" means a graduate-level student of the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University. "Committee" means the Graduate Scholarship Consideration Committee.

"Scholarship" means the Scholarship for Young Scientists for the academic year 2026.

**Item 2** Types of Scholarships, Characteristics of Scholarship Provision, and Duration of Scholarship

#### **2.1 Type 1 (Supporting partial tuition fees)**

2.1.1 The Student pays the semester tuition fee themselves (5,500 Baht/semester).

2.1.2 The Faculty of Science supports a lump sum tuition fee after deducting the semester fee for a period of 1 academic year (first semester and second semester), with details as follows:

2.1.2.1 The Program advances the lump sum tuition fee after deducting the semester tuition fee, and will be reimbursed 65% from the Graduate School and 35% from the Faculty of Science.

2.1.2.2 Exemption from tuition fee allocation for all courses beginning with SC.

## **2.2 Type 2 (Supporting partial tuition fees and monthly expenses)**

### **Total of 75 scholarships**

2.2.1 The Student pays the semester tuition fee themselves (5,500 Baht/semester).

2.2.2 The Faculty of Science supports a lump sum tuition fee after deducting the semester fee for a period of 1 academic year (first semester and second semester), with details as follows:

2.2.2.1 The Program advances the lump sum tuition fee after deducting the semester tuition fee, and will be reimbursed 65% from the Graduate School and 35% from the Faculty of Science.

2.2.2.2 Exemption from tuition fee allocation for all courses beginning with SC.

2.2.3 The Faculty of Science supports a monthly expense allowance for a period of 12 months, 8,000 Baht per month.

### **Item 3 Applicant Qualifications**

3.1 Must have been selected to be a graduate student in a program within the Faculty of Science, Mahidol University, for the academic year 2026, and have good academic performance as follows:

#### **3.1.1 Applicants for Type 1 Scholarship:**

3.1.1.1 Master's degree level: Completed a bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of less than 3.00.

3.1.1.2 Doctoral degree level: Completed a bachelor's or master's degree with a cumulative GPA of less than 3.25.

**3.1.2 Applicants for Type 2 Scholarship:**

3.1.2.1 Master's degree level: Completed a bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher.

3.1.2.2 Doctoral degree level: Completed a bachelor's or master's degree with a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher.

3.2 Must not be receiving other types of scholarships that support both tuition fees and monthly expenses concurrently.

**Item 4 Obligations during the Scholarship Period**

4.1 Must complete work assistance hours within the Faculty of Science or participate in community service activities utilizing scientific knowledge for not less than 10 hours per academic year, and

4.2 Must proctor central examinations of the Faculty of Science for not less than 9 hours per semester, according to the date, time, and location specified by the Faculty of Science.

4.3 The department or Program shall collect performance results and report them to the Faculty of Science at the end of each semester using the specified form.

**Item 5 Qualifications of the Candidates**

5.1 Must be a full-time student.

5.2 Must register for no less than 9 credits per semester, excluding credits registered as Audit (AU), except in cases of registration according to the study plan of that specific Program.

5.3 the Student receives financial support from another source that only provides a monthly expense allowance, they can still apply for the Type 1 Scholarship.

5.4 the Student receives financial support from another source that only provides registration/tuition fee support, they can still apply for the Type 2 Scholarship, but

will only receive the monthly expense allowance.

5.5 the Student who has already received this Scholarship subsequently applies for and receives another scholarship from another source, the Student must return the tuition fees and monthly expenses received from the Faculty of Science in full.

**Item 6** Termination/Conclusion of Scholarship

The Scholarship will be terminated in any of the following cases:

6.1 The scholarship recipient requests withdrawal from student status during the Scholarship period.

6.2 The scholarship recipient behaves inappropriately or commits a serious

disciplinary offense according to Mahidol University regulations.

6.3 The scholarship recipient provides false information or fails to report receiving scholarships from other sources during the Scholarship period.

6.4 Other unforeseen circumstances that prevent the Student from continuing their studies.

6.5 Upon the end of the Scholarship period or the Student's death.

6.6 If the Scholarship termination is due to cases under item 6.1 - 6.4, the department or Program must report to the Faculty of Science within 15 days, and the Student must return the tuition fees and monthly expenses received from the Faculty of Science in full.

**Furthermore,** the reimbursement of Scholarship funds for recipients due to unforeseen circumstances other than those mentioned above, and where the recipient cannot be contacted, such as international students returning to their home countries and being unreachable, shall be considered by the Committee which has the authority to propose to the Dean of the Faculty of Science for final judgment and order.

**Item 7** Scholarship Application Procedures

7.1 The Faculty of Science announces the Scholarship availability.

7.2 The department or Program reviews and selects Students who meet all qualifications and submits their names to the Faculty of Science along with supporting

documents as follows:

- (1) Scholarship application form for the Scholarship for Young Scientists
- (2) A 3 cm. x 4 cm. photograph
- (3) A copy of the academic transcript

7.3 The Faculty of Science announces the list of scholarship recipients by notifying the departments or Programs.

If it is found after receiving the Scholarship that the applicant submitted incomplete, incorrect, or false documents, or does not meet the specified criteria, even if they have already received the Scholarship, the Student will be disqualified from receiving the Scholarship and must return the tuition fees and monthly expenses received by the Faculty of Science in full.

<u>Round 3</u>	July 13, 2026

##### **Application Schedule for Semester 2** (10 scholarships): October 1 – 30, 2026

**Announcement Date:** November 24, 2026

If the number of recipients in each round does not reach the announced number of scholarships, the remaining scholarships can be carried over to the next round within the same academic year.

**Item 9** The disbursement of funds under this announcement shall be made from the Faculty of Science revenue in accordance with the Mahidol University Regulations regarding Budget and Financial Management B.E. 2551 and its amendments.
